

Workstation Imaging and Deployment

A Regional Private School contacted Interphase Systems to assist with the deployment of over 120 laptop computers to faculty and staff. The School had just purchased 120 laptop computers prior to the director of information technology resigning. After careful examination of the existing infrastructure, Interphase Systems recommended the installation of Windows Server 2003 and Systems Management Server. By applying these technologies Interphase was able to quickly and efficiently deploy the unique images to all student and faculty computers, while providing tight control over configuration, installed software, and user permissions.

Periodic revisions of the laptop configuration could easily be applied and deployed via SMS 2003 allowing for “zero touch”



updates. When significant modifications to the image were required SMS allowed for “light touch imaging”, which significantly reduced deployment time and costs.
